
# REPLACEMENT

HINT:

- Use the same procedures for the RH side and LH side.
- The procedures listed below are for the LH side.
- Installation is in the reverse order of removal.
- 1. PRECAUTION (SEE PAGE 60–1)
- 2. DISCONNECT BATTERY NEGATIVE TERMINAL (SEE PAGE 60–1)
- 3. REMOVE FRONT DOOR SCUFF PLATE (SEE PAGE 61–9)
- 4. REMOVE REAR DOOR SCUFF PLATE (SEE PAGE 61–9)
- 5. REMOVE FRONT DOOR OPENING TRIM WEATHERSTRIP (SEE PAGE 61–9)
- 6. REMOVE REAR DOOR OPENING TRIM WEATHERSTRIP (SEE PAGE 61–9)
- 7. REMOVE CENTER PILLAR GARNISH LOWER (SEE PAGE 61–9)
- 8. REMOVE FRONT SEAT OUTER BELT ASSY (SEE PAGE 61–9)



- REMOVE SIDE AIRBAG SENSOR ASSY
- (a) Disconnect the connector from the side airbag sensor assy.
- (b) Remove the 2 nuts and the side airbag sensor assy.

### 10. INSTALL SIDE AIRBAG SENSOR ASSY

- (a) Check that the power switch is off.
- (b) Check that the battery negative (-) terminal is disconnected.

### CAUTION:

After removing the terminal, wait for at least 90 seconds before starting the operation.

(c) Install the side airbag sensor assy with the 2 nuts.

### Torque: 9.0 N⋅m (92 kgf⋅cm, 80 in. lbf)

## NOTICE:

- If the side airbag sensor assy has been dropped, or there are any cracks, dents or other defects in the case, bracket or connector, replace it with a new one.
- When installing the side airbag sensor assy, be careful that the SRS wiring does not interfere with other parts and that it is not pinched between other parts.
- (d) Check that there is no looseness in the installation parts of the side airbag sensor assy.
- (e) Connect the connector to the side airbag sensor assy.
- 11. INSTALL FRONT SEAT OUTER BELT ASSY (SEE PAGE 61-9)
- 12. CONNECT BATTERY NEGATIVE TERMINAL

### NOTICE:

When disconnecting the negative (–) battery terminal, initialize the following systems after the terminal is reconnected.
