

## **REAR BRAKE FLEXIBLE HOSE**

### **COMPONENTS**



#### **REMOVAL**

#### HINT:

- Use the same procedures for the LH side and RH side.
- The procedures listed below are for the LH side.
- 1. REMOVE REAR WHEEL
- 2. DRAIN BRAKE FLUID NOTICE:


Wash off brake fluid immediately if it comes in contact with any painted surface.


#### 3. REMOVE REAR BRAKE TUBE FLEXIBLE HOSE

(a) Disconnect the brake tube (labeled A) from the flexible hose with SST while holding the flexible hose with a wrench.

#### SST 09023-00101 NOTICE:

- Do not bend or damage the brake tube.
- Do not allow any foreign matter such as dirt and dust to enter the brake tube from the connecting point.
- (b) Remove the clip (labeled B).
- (c) Remove the union bolt and gasket(s), and then remove the flexible hose from the disc brake cylinder.
