REMOVAL

HINT:

- Use the same procedures for the LH side and RH side.
- The procedures listed below are for the LH side.
- 1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL


CAUTION:

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.


- 2. REMOVE FRONT DOOR SCUFF PLATE LH (See page IR-26)
- 3. REMOVE FRONT DOOR OPENING TRIM WEATHERSTRIP LH
- 4. REMOVE REAR DOOR SCUFF PLATE LH (See page IR-29)
- 5. REMOVE REAR DOOR OPENING TRIM WEATHERSTRIP LH



- (a) Remove the lap belt anchor cover.
- (b) Remove the anchor's built-in bolt from the pillar and disconnect the outer belt.




- (c) Using a screwdriver, detach the 2 claws. HINT:

- (d) Using a clip remover, detach the 2 clips and remove the garnish.




7. REMOVE CENTER PILLAR GARNISH LH

- (c) Pull out the outer belt anchor from the center pillar garnish.









8. REMOVE FRONT SEAT OUTER BELT ASSEMBLY LH


(a) Remove the nut and disconnect the shoulder anchor.

(c) Remove the bolt and outer belt.




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9. REMOVE FRONT SHOULDER BELT ANCHOR PLATE SUB-ASSEMBLY LH


- (a) Using a screwdriver, detach the 6 claws.
- (b) Remove the anchor plate from the garnish. HINT:

Tape the screwdriver tip before use.



10. REMOVE FRONT SHOULDER BELT ANCHOR ADJUSTER ASSEMBLY

(a) Remove the 2 bolts and anchor.



INSPECTION

1. INSPECT FRONT SEAT OUTER BELT ASSEMBLY NOTICE:

Do not disassemble the retractor.

- (a) Before installing the outer belt, check the ELR.
 - (1) When the inclination of the retractor is 15° or less, check that the belt can be pulled from the retractor. When the inclination of the retractor is over 45°, check that the belt locks. If the result is not as specified, replace the outer belt assembly.
