## INSPECTION PROCEDURE

### 1 CHECK SURROUNDING CONDITIONS


(a) Check if a cellular phone can make calls in a certain place.

**OK: It can make calls.**

**NG** END (CELLULAR PHONES CAN ONLY FUNCTION IN CELLULAR SERVICE AREAS)

### 2 CHECK RECEPTION




(a) Check if the reception level is the same on a cellular phone and the multi-display.

**OK: The reception level is different.**

**NG** REPLACE MULTI-DISPLAY (SEE PAGE 67-7)

**OK**

**3 CHECK RECEPTION**



- (a) Place a cellular phone close to the multi-display.
  - (b) Check if the reception level becomes the same on the cellular phone and the multi-display.
- OK: The reception level does not become the same.**

**NG** REPLACE MULTI-DISPLAY (SEE PAGE 67-7)

**OK**

**END (MULTI-DISPLAY RECEIVES THE DIFFERENT STRENGTH OF RADIO WAVE DEPENDING ON THE RADIO WAVES STRENGTH TRANSMITTED BY CELLULAR PHONE)**
