CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION

The D squib (Dual stage – 2nd step) circuit consists of the airbag ECU assy, the spiral cable sub–assy and the horn button assy.

The circuit instructs the SRS to deploy when deployment conditions are met.

DTC B1810 is recorded when a short circuit is detected in the D squib (Dual stage - 2nd step) circuit.

INSPECTION PROCEDURE

- (c) Disconnect the connectors from the airbag ECU assy.
- Disconnect the connectors from the horn button assy. (d)
- Disconnect the connectors from the front passenger airbag assy. (e)
- (f) Disconnect the connector from the front seat airbag assy LH.
- Disconnect the connector from the front seat airbag assy RH. (g)
- Disconnect the connector from the curtain shield airbag assy LH. (h)
- Disconnect the connector from the curtain shield airbag assy RH. (i)
- Disconnect the connector from the front seat outer belt assy LH. (j)
- (k) Disconnect the connector from the front seat outer belt assy RH.
