
BACK DOOR STAY

REPLACEMENT

HINT:

- The installation procedures are the removal procedures in reverse order. However, only installation procedures requiring additional information are included.
- Use the same procedures for the RH side and LH side.
- The procedures listed below are for the LH side.
- A bolt without a torque specification is shown in the standard bolt chart (see page 03–2).




1. REMOVE BACK DOOR STAY ASSY LH

- (a) Using a screwdriver, remove the 2 stop rings and stay.
- (b) Remove the bolt labeled A from the door panel. HINT:

Remove the door stay while supporting the back door with your hands.

(c) Remove the 2 bolts labeled B and the stay bracket from the body panel.



2. INSTALL BACK DOOR STAY ASSY LH

(a) Install the stay bracket with the 2 bolts. **Torque:**

7.0 N m (71 kgf cm, 62 in. lbf) for bolt labeled B

(b) Install the back door stay bolt to the back door. **Torque:**

22.0 N·m (224 kgf·cm, 16 ft·lbf) for bolt labeled A
(c) Install the stay with the 2 stop rings.
