

- 3. REMOVE GLOVE COMPARTMENT DOOR (SEE PAGE 71–7)




- 4. DISCONNECT FRONT PASSENGER AIRBAG ASSY CONNECTOR

When handling the airbag connector, take care not to damage the airbag wire harness.


5. REMOVE INSTRUMENT PANEL SUB-ASSY W/PASSENGER AIRBAG ASSY (SEE PAGE 71-7)

- (a) Disconnect the connectors from the front passenger airbag assy.






- 10. CONNECT INSTRUMENT PANEL WIRE ASSY
