

REMOVAL

1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL


CAUTION:

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.


- 2. REMOVE STEERING COLUMN COVER LOWER
 - (a) Remove the steering column cover lower (see page SR-12).



(a) Disconnect the ignition switch connector.




- (b) Disconnect the ignition key cylinder light connector.
- (c) Remove the 2 screws and ignition switch.




INSPECTION

- 1. INSPECT IGNITION SWITCH ASSEMBLY
 - (a) Measure the resistance of the switch. **Standard resistance**
