
IGNITION KEY CYLINDER LIGHT

COMPONENTS



REMOVAL

1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY CAUTION:

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.

- 2. PLACE FRONT WHEELS FACING STRAIGHT AHEAD
- 3. REMOVE STEERING PAD ASSEMBLY (See page RS-336)
- 4. REMOVE STEERING WHEEL ASSEMBLY (See page SR-12)
- 5. REMOVE STEERING COLUMN COVER (See page SR-12)
- 6. REMOVE TRANSPONDER KEY AMPLIFIER (See page SR-14)

INSPECTION



- (a) w/ Engine immobiliser system:
 - (1) Connect the battery's positive (+) lead to terminal 2 and the negative (-) lead to terminal 6, and then check that the light comes on.OK:

LED illuminates.

If the result is not as specified, replace the transponder key amplifier.

- (b) w/o Engine immobiliser system:
 - Connect the battery's positive (+) lead to terminal 2 and the negative (-) lead to terminal 1, and then check that the light comes on.
 OK:

LED illuminates.
