

REMOVAL

CAUTION:

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.

1. REMOVE SHOULDER BELT ANCHOR COVER RH

(a) Using a screwdriver, remove the 4 claws and cover. HINT:

Tape the screwdriver tip before use.


2. REMOVE ROOF HEADLINING ASSEMBLY HINT:

It is not necessary to completely remove the roof headlining. Slightly lower the rear section of the roof headlining.

(a) Partially remove the roof headlining (see page IR-26).


3. REMOVE REAR CENTER SEAT OUTER BELT ASSEMBLY

(a) Remove the 2 bolts and seat belt.

INSPECTION

1. INSPECT REAR CENTER SEAT OUTER BELT ASSEMBLY

NOTICE:


Do not disassemble the retractor.

(a) When the inclination of the retractor is 15° or less, check that the belt can be pulled from the retractor. When the inclination of the retractor is over 45°, check that the belt locks.

If the operation is not as specified, replace the belt.

INSTALLATION

- 1. INSTALL REAR CENTER SEAT OUTER BELT ASSEMBLY
 - (a) Install the seat belt with the 2 bolts.
 Torque: 42 N*m (428 kgf*cm, 31 ft.*lbf)
- 2. INSTALL ROOF HEADLINING ASSEMBLY
 - (a) Install the roof headlining (see page IR-49).



3. INSTALL SHOULDER BELT ANCHOR COVER RH (a) Install the cover with the 4 claws.
