
## **REMOVAL**

**DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL** 

**CAUTION:** 

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.

- **REMOVE FRONT SEAT ASSEMBLY (for Manual Seat)** (See page SE-11)
- 3. REMOVE OCCUPANT CLASSIFICATION ECU
  - (a) Disconnect the 2 connectors from the occupant classification ECU.
  - (b) Using a screwdriver, remove the occupant classification ECU.



## INSTALLATION

- 1. INSTALL OCCUPANT CLASSIFICATION ECU
  - (a) Check that the ignition switch is off.
  - (b) Check that the negative battery (-) terminal is disconnected.

## CAUTION:

After disconnecting the negative battery terminal, wait for at least 90 seconds before starting the operation.

- (c) Install the occupant classification ECU.
- (d) Connect the 2 connectors to the occupant classification ECU.

## NOTICE:

- If the occupant classification ECU has been dropped, or there are any cracks, dents or other defects in the case or connector, replace it with a new one.
- When installing the occupant classification ECU, be careful that the SRS wiring does not interfere with other parts and that it is not pinched between other parts.
- 2. INSTALL FRONT SEAT ASSEMBLY (for Manual Seat) (See page SE-23)
- 3. CONNECT CABLE TO NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL
- 4. INSPECT SLIDE ADJUSTER LOCK (for Manual Seat)
- 5. INSPECT SEAT HEATER OPERATION (w/ Seat Heater System)
- 6. INSPECT SRS WARNING LIGHT
  - (a) Inspect the SRS warning light (see page RS-245).
