

- The procedures listed below are for the LH side.
- 1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL

**CAUTION:** 

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.

- 2. REMOVE FRONT DOOR SCUFF PLATE LH (See page IR-26)
- 3. REMOVE REAR DOOR SCUFF PLATE LH (See page IR-57)
- 4. REMOVE CENTER PILLAR GARNISH LOWER LH (See page SB-27)
- 5. REMOVE SIDE AIRBAG SENSOR ASSEMBLY LH
  - (a) Disconnect the connector.
  - (b) Remove the bolt and sensor.



INSTALLATION

- INSTALL SIDE AIRBAG SENSOR ASSEMBLY LH
  - (a) Install the sensor with the bolt.

Torque: 9.0 N\*m (92 kgf\*cm, 82 in.\*lbf) NOTICE:

- If the airbag sensor has been dropped, or there are any cracks, dents or other defects in the case, bracket or connector, replace it with a new one.
- When installing the airbag sensor, be careful that the SRS wiring does not interfere with other parts and that it is not pinched between other parts.
- (b) Check that there is no looseness in the installation parts of the sensor.
- (c) Connect the connector.
- 2. INSTALL CENTER PILLAR GARNISH LOWER LH (See page SB-31)
- 3. INSTALL REAR DOOR SCUFF PLATE LH (See page IR-57)
- 4. INSTALL FRONT DOOR SCUFF PLATE LH (See page IR-59)
- 5. CONNECT CABLE TO NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL
- 6. CHECK SRS WARNING LIGHT
  - (a) Check the SRS warning light (see page RS-34).
